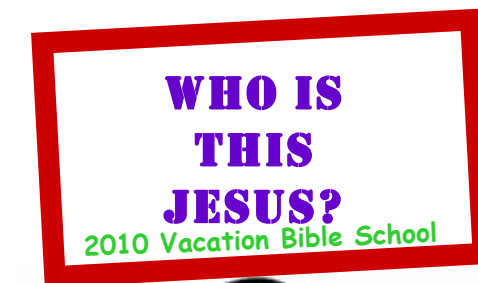

### Who is Jesus?

Being a Christian is about more than gathering for a good time... it's about serving our brothers and sisters. Each night there will also be an intergenerational service project where children, parents and other members of our church family will together be the hands and feet of Christ.

### **8:00 Family sending**

We'll wrap up the evening with more songs and prayer, as well as a recap from James Jory Jenkins.

### **8:20 Dessert and fellowship**

Time together as a large group before heading home for the night!
